2021 Harvest Report

The 2021 season was one of exceptional quality and will be remembered for low yields with intensely flavored, small berries and incredible color. Here in St. Helena, rain started in January and then almost no notable precipitation for the rest of the season. Budbreak was early April followed by flowering and bloom in May. The summer saw early and even ripening throughout. Harvest started on August 13th, picking Sauvignon Blanc and finished with the last red grapes coming in September 27th. Overall, the 2021 Crocker & Starr wines are showing brilliant concentration and intense color, which will lead to full-bodied, age-worthy wines.

Tasting Notes

2021 Cabernet Franc has a deep violet blue color with intense and inviting aromas of black raspberry, violets and cardamom. True to the Crocker & Starr style, the silky entry unfolds to flavors of ripe black raspberry and blueberry, sweet tobacco and Mexican chocolate with lots of fine tannins that lead to a mouthwatering long finish. Decant this young Cab Franc now to unfold layers of flavor and texture. Age-worthy 15+ years.
