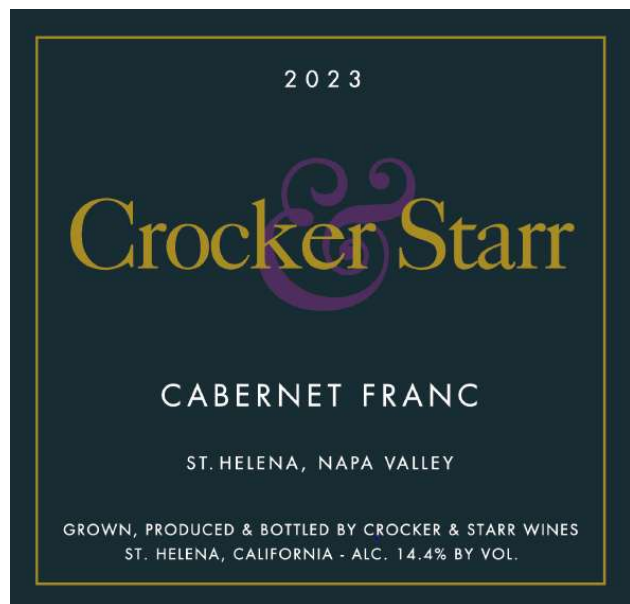




2023 Estate Cabernet Franc

Gone Green

As a **Certified Napa Green Vineyard & Winery and Fish Friendly Farming** operation, we follow regenerative practices to reduce our carbon footprint. Efforts include an electric tractor, sheep grazing for cover crops, insect-friendly habitats, no-till farming, and a yearly farm plan. We also maintain an employee garden, employ no-entry tank rule for safety, adopt labor-saving equipment, and reduction in glass bottle weight; all to protect the land, preserve biodiversity, and craft wines with lasting integrity.

2023 Harvest Report

A throwback year reminiscent of the long, and later growing seasons typical of the early 2000s, with budbreak occurring at the end of March. We experienced a bit of weather 'highs and lows' during flowering and fruit set, which only mildly reduced the yield in a couple of vineyard blocks. The growing season was moderate and well-paced, providing our vineyard team with plenty of time to manage the vines. Overall, it was an even and steady growing season. Our Sauvignon Blanc harvest began in the first week of September, with our last black grapes coming in from the vineyard in the first week of November. It was a relaxed, unhurried growing season, resulting in fresh and balanced wines.

Tasting Notes

A powerhouse of precision, the 2023 vintage presents a saturated dark garnet in the glass, erupting with an intense perfume of black raspberry, violets, and underpinned by an intriguing, savory edge of lavender and dried ancho-chili. The palate is a masterclass in texture—silky on entry yet exploding with brooding dark fruits, graphite, and exotic cardamom. There is a remarkable density to the mid-palate, held in perfect check by vibrant, mouthwatering acidity. It concludes with an "everlasting" finish of elegant, fine-grained tannins that signal immense aging potential.

Cellar Note: Restrained in its youth, this wine benefits from decanting now and promises generous rewards for those patient enough to cellar it for two decades or more.
